Policy Statement

WRK digital is committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in any part of our business or in our supply chains. We will not tolerate or condone any form of modern slavery, including forced labour, bonded labour, human trafficking, or any other form of slavery or servitude.

We will ensure that all of our employees, workers, and suppliers are treated with respect and dignity, and we will not knowingly engage in any business relationships that involve modern slavery or human trafficking.

Compliance

We will comply with all relevant legislation, including the Modern Slavery Act 2015, and any other regulations or guidance relating to modern slavery and human trafficking.

Risk Assessment and Due Diligence

Training
